Declarations of Interest to receive Pecuniary and Non-Pecuniary Interests from Cllrs on items to be considered at this meeting. Item 5.a Cllr Williams – Friend of the planning applicant Item 5.b Cllr Sturzaker – The property being considered in the planning application is adjacent to Cllr Sturzaker's residence. Item 5.c Cllr Sturzaker – The planning applicant is a client of Cllr Sturzaker's partner.</p>

Y07 3LQ (Extension granted) Cllr Williams left the room before the planning application was discussed. At 6.03pm Cllr Reid came into the Village Hall to give her apologies and to also bring in correspondence connected to the cemetery. Cllr Reid left the Village Hall at 6.08pm. Her apology was not discussed by the members. The members discussed item 5.a – Resolved - the members Support the planning application with no comments. Parish Clerk to action. Cllr Williams re-entered the room. 5.b Planning Application – 23/01134/FUL – Forge Cottage, Dishforth. Y07 3JU (No reply – extension request) Before Cllr Sturzaker left the room, Cllr G West was voted as Chairman by the members for items 5.b and 5.c. Cllr Sturzaker left the room before the planning application was discussed. The members discussed item 5.b – Resolved - the members Support the planning application with no comments. Parish Clerk to action. Cllr Sturzaker did not re-enter the room. 5.c Planning Application – 23/00183/FUL – Springfield Barn, Lingham Lane, Dishforth. Y07 3LF (Extension granted) Cllr G West informed the members of the planning application in detail and felt that the property was in keeping with other properties in the village. Cllr Williams felt that the property was an unnecessary development. Cllr K West was concerned with visibility issues as the access from the road is narrow, Resolved – the members Support the planning application by a majority. Two councillors support the application, and one councillor is against the application. The application is supported with the following comments: The PC reiterates the local highway authority in connection to the property's planned access from a narrow lane with restricted visibility. Cllr Sturzaker re-entered the Village Hall.</p>
