The parishioner was thanked for their comments. The members discussed the application and reported on the following: There have been no objections to the application There has been 1 comment of support for the application Dishforth Parish Council Support the planning application, however, would ask that the following comments are considered: The planning application is not expecting to have a drainage system. If that is the case, how will the water be drained away? Conditions applied to S106 concerning the new build. Namely, that the application is given permission that the landowner/developer does not attempt to change the approval build. There is a Construction Management Plan in place to ensure that the road (Back Lane) which is narrow through road is unimpeded for traffic through the construction There is a Construction Management plan in place to alleviate safety concerns for all pedestrians as there are no footpaths on Back Lane at that point which is walking route to school for children Turning point – removal of the wall. In the current plans for two dwellings. The plans show no garages and a small wall separating the drives. Turning space is limited and there is insufficient parking for visitors and delivery vehicles. Reoving the wall separating the drives would enable delivery vehicles in, park and drive out of the drives, preventing obstruction to traffic on Back Lane. Parish Clerk to action.</p>
